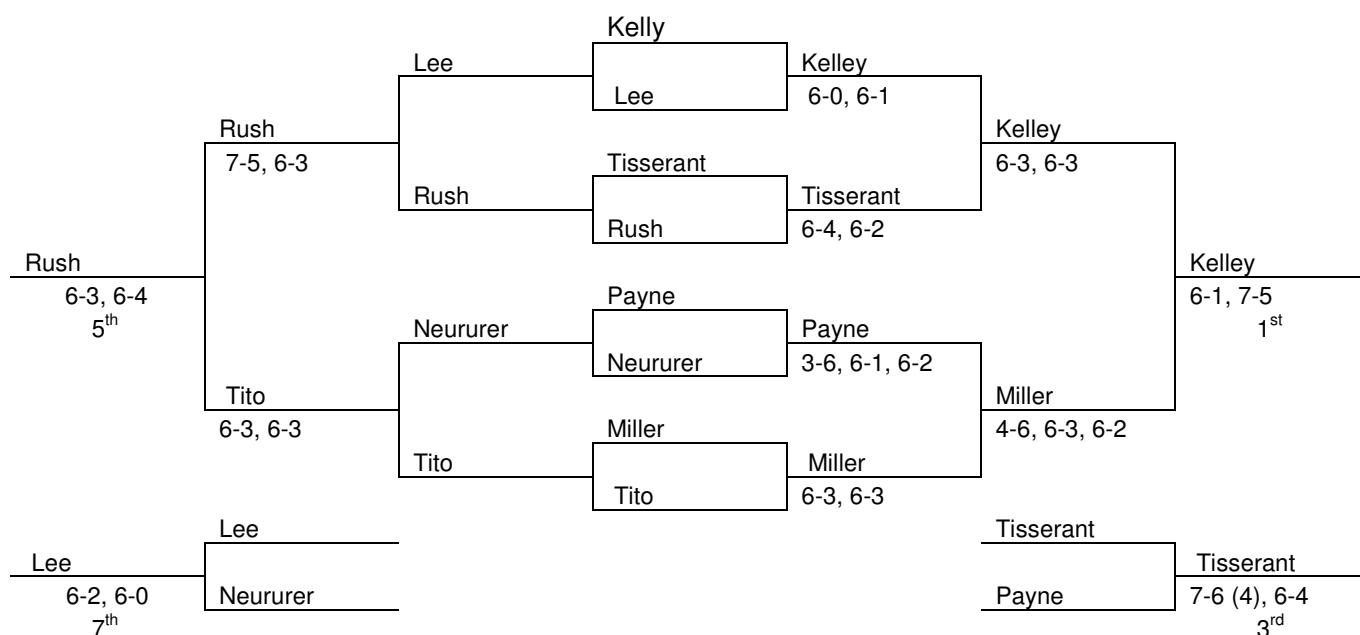

## KNOCKOUT DRAW POSITION:

- Line 1 - winner pool A
- Line 2 - runner up pool D
- Line 3 - either winner of Pool B or Pool C - flip of the coin UNLESS winner of B is from same country as Winner of A or D in which case the winner of B is placed in the opposite half to the player from their country.
- Line 4 - based on determination of line 3 place runner up from pool B or C. This means if winner pool B is in line 3 then runner up pool C must be in line 4 and vice versa - NO flip as flip for line 3 determines ALL other places in the draw.
- Line 5 - reverse of line 4 - runner up in pool C or B
- Line 6 - reverse of line 3 - winner of pool C or B
- Line 7 - runner-up Pool A
- Line 8 - winner pool D

Hence there is only one flip for the whole draw and that is only if winners of B and C are not from the same country as winners of A and D.
